Justifications provided by the requesting Implementing Office:

 Change in end station limits due to constraint in budget allocation caused by the reduction in allotment from the FY 2025 National Expenditure Program (NEP) in the approved FY 2025 General Appropriations Act (GAA).

Increase in unit cost can also be attributed to utilization of Anti-Rutting Additive (ARA) to prevent the road surface from rutting since this section is located on a mountainous terrain that also serves as an alternate route wherein a large volume of traffic traverses including heavy and 10-wheeler cargo trucks as well as the inclusion of concrete re-blocking of existing pavement at intermittent sections from a thickness of 230mm to 300mm Reinforced PCCP and miscellaneous structures such as application of reflectorized thermoplastic pavement markings in order to address and provide engineering solutions to road safety concerns as well as for operational efficiency and effective implementation of the project.

. Adjustment in physical target from 3.363 lane km to 2.249 lane km as per approved Detailed Engineering Design and Program of Works due to correction of alignments and curvatures along some portions which can also be substantiated as the road section traverses towards the mountainous region of the Project Influence Area. The derived unit cost of physical target was based on approved Plans, POW, DUPA, and CMPD.
